JEFFREY LEVEE DECLARATION IN SUPPORT OF ICANN'S TRO APPLICATION

I, Jeffrey A. LeVee, declare:

- 1. I am a partner with the law firm Jones Day, counsel of record for plaintiff Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") in this action. I am admitted to practice law before this Court. I submit this declaration in support of Plaintiff's application for a temporary restraining order against RegisterFly.Com, Inc., and UnifiedNames, Inc. (collectively referred to as "RegisterFly"). I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and am competent to testify if called as a witness.
- 2. On the morning of Wednesday, March 28, 2007, I directed Samantha Eisner, an associate with Jones Day, to electronically mail a letter drafted by me, entitled "Notice of Lawsuit to be Filed March 29, 2007" (the "Notice Letter") to:



- 3. The Notice Letter specifically informs RegisterFly that, on March 29, 2007, ICANN "will file this suit" and file an "ex parte application seeking a temporary restraining order" against RegisterFly.
- 4. The Notice Letter also informs RegisterFly: (1) where ICANN plans to file suit: "the United States District Court for the Central District of California"; (2) why ICANN is filing suit: "RegisterFly has continued to fail to send to ICANN a complete and accurate copy of the current registration data that ICANN has not requested multiple times pursuant to Section 3.6 of the Registrar Accreditation Agreement ("RAA"). RegisterFly's failure to provide the data constitutes a breach of the RAA and places RegisterFly's customers in great jeopardy;" and (3) the date and time the suit will be filed: "ICANN will file this suit on Wednesday, March 29, 2007, prior to 3 p.m. Pacific Daylight Time."
- 5. I will oversee the providing of courtesy copies of the file-stamped Complaint and Application to Mr. Medina, Mr. Rabner and Mr. Novick by close of business on March 29, 2007 via federal express. Additionally, within one hour of the filing of the temporary restraining order ("TRO") papers, I will electronically mail a courtesy copy of all the TRO papers to Mr. Medina, Mr. Rabner, and Mr. Novick. In addition, ICANN is arranging for personal service of the complaint and the TRO papers on RegisterFly's agent for service of process.

RegisterFly has continued to fail to send to ICANN a complete and accurate copy of the current registration data that ICANN has now requested multiple times pursuant to Section 3.6 of the Registrar Accreditation Agreement ("RAA"). RegisterFly's failure to provide that data constitutes a breach of the RAA and places RegisterFly's customers in great jeopardy.

Because of ICANN's strong and increasing concern that RegisterFly's customers will be irreparably harmed if RegisterFly does not escrow with ICANN a current copy of all registration data – as well as rolling updates of the data every 48 hours (as ICANN has repeatedly requested) – this letter constitutes official notice that ICANN will be filing suit against RegisterFly in the United States District Court for the Central District of California. ICANN will file this suit on March 29, 2007, prior to 3 p.m. Pacific Daylight Time. ICANN also will file an ex parte application seeking a temporary restraining order, requiring RegisterFly to turn over to ICANN all of the data that ICANN has requested and to require RegisterFly to provide ICANN updates of this data every 48 hours.

With respect to ICANN's application for a temporary restraining order, we urge you and your counsel to consult the Local Rules of the Federal District Court for the Central District of California and, in particular, Local Rule 7-19. We will serve you with a copy of the papers via Federal Express, and (if you request) we will provide a copy of the papers by email. ICANN also will send copies to your counsel, as requested in Mitchell Novick's March 22, 2007 email to Amy A. Stathos of ICANN.
