ICANN has conducted a preliminary review of VeriSign's request for a Registry Lock Service for .NAME, pursuant to the .NAME Registry Agreement between VeriSign and ICANN dated 15 August 2007.

Based on the information provided, ICANN's preliminary review did not identify any significant competition, security or stability issues. The proposal is very similar to VeriSign's proposal 2009005 for .COM and .NET already approved on July 2009. VeriSign may proceed as proposed.
