

Dear ICANN accredited registrar,

The Internet Engineering Task Force (IETF) has published <u>RFC 9276 (Guidance for NSEC3 Parameter Settings)</u> with new best practices for DNS zone publishers, and validating resolvers.

If you offer DNSSEC services and use NSEC3 in doing so, ICANN org recommends that you review and consider RFC 9276's new guidance. Please note that per RFC 9276, section 3.2, DNSSEC validating resolvers may no longer resolve signed names properly or securely for zones that do not follow the new best practices for zone publishers.
