



Dear Registrar,

In our message of 6 August, we communicated a target date of 16 September 2019 to retire RADAR and transition to version 2.0 of the Naming Services portal (NSp) for registrars. After further testing, we have decided to postpone this launch date and are in the process of re-planning the launch.

Version 2.0 of the NSp for registrars will enable the registrar primary contact to manage contact roles and authorize additional credentialed users. As part of this upgrade, the RADAR system will be retired and the NSp will become the system of record for registrar contact data.

To complete the transition from RADAR to the NSp, the RADAR system will be placed into a read-only mode approximately one week prior to the launch of the new version of the NSp. The ICANN org will notify users at least five days ahead of the read-only period.

In preparation to gain access to the new portal, we kindly request that you verify that all of your contact information is up to date in RADAR as soon as possible. Please also utilize the resources listed below to familiarize yourself with the new NSp.
