This letter is to inform you that ICANN has approved Telnic's request for the equitable allocation of single and two-character ASCII domain names.

ICANN's preliminary determination did not identify any significant competition or security and stability issues. Telnic's request for the equitable allocation program is consistent with what has been previously approved for numerous gTLD registries. Furthermore, similar requests have been approved for other gTLD registries and that the public comment on the request received one relevant submission, and it was supportive.

Telnic may proceed with the allocation of single and two-character ASCII domain names.
