#### **Global Domains Division Charter**

The Global Domains Division is the unit of ICANN that engages the Internet community to implement ICANN domain name policies through contracts and services, and delivers IANA functions.

Purpose	<ul> <li>To serve the global public interest, the registrants and end users of the Internet by ensuring a secure and stable domain name system (DNS), while promoting trust, choice, and competition in the trusted domain name service industry</li> </ul>
How we go about this	<ul> <li>By earning the trust of our stake-holders, by holding ourselves and our contracted parties to high standards of conduct, and by optimizing our operations in order to provide high quality, secure services that can scale to support global expansion.</li> </ul>
Our Ultimate Goal	<ul> <li>To be respected for operational excellence within a trusted global market for domain name services.</li> </ul>

- Obtain a greater understanding of the challenges facing registries and registrars and improve our knowledge of how the domain name marketplace functions.
- Ensure the ICANN organization's staff continues to address domain ecosystem challenges with greater sensitivity to global, regional issues that impact both businesses and communities that participate in the ICANN organization.
- Increase proactive communication that contains greater context and rationale regarding our decisions while remaining accountable to serving the needs of the ICANN community.
- O Focus our efforts on designing solutions with greater emphasis on simplicity to ensure contracted parties' adoption.

#### **Response Activities: Better understand the business & regional sensitivities**

- Educate staff by broadening staff's understanding of the Domain Name Industry **business** and the impact of policy on business

  - Attend non-ICANN industry events
  - Develop mechanisms for gathering & sharing knowledge more effectively across GDD
