WHO?



WHEN?


Jan-Feb: Initial capture of process flows
Mar-Apr: Review current state maps with Board
May-Jun: Engagement with community
June-July: Finalize next






Using process flows to capture detail, flag risk areas and drive alignment


Get down the basic, detailed flow using Visio.



More detailed illustrations to make these "people processes" easier to understand, and facilitate conversation and more detailed capture of steps, sub steps and areas of possible confusion. This is also a step that can help validate the detail in the visio diagrams.



Once we have clarity and alignment with community, final process flows and documentation can be produced.







Clarity on Areas of Potential Impasse

This effort has helped identify areas in the process where potential impasse could occur.

Potential impasse is any situation in which the parties involved can't, or won't, move forward or make progress and which does not concern a natural end point or the start of other processes or procedures.

Existing mechanisms and processes can be used to try to resolve the impasse.

As ICANN org and the community work through the impasse, approach utilized will be captured so that institutional knowledge is preserved.
