In the Affirmation of Commitments, ICANN undertook to "maintain and improve robust mechanisms for public input, accountability, and transparency so as to ensure that the outcomes of its decision-making will reflect the public interest and be accountable to all stakeholders." I am writing to express my interest in serving as a representative of the Country-code Name Supporting Organization on the team charged with reviewing ICANN's progress with respect to this goal.

I believe that I possess the requisite skills and personal characteristics to serve on this panel. I have participated in ICANN since its inception and in a wide variety of roles including as a member of the GAC, a legal advisor for several existing and prospective top level domain registries, and as a Nominating Committee appointee to the ccnso Council.
