Mr.ZHANG Xinsheng, born in 1953, is the counsel with the Telecommunications Administration Bureau, the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT), holding concurrently the positions of the Standing Council Member of China Institute of Communications, Deputy Secretary-General of Communications Science & Technology Commission, MIIT and Deputy Secretary-General of China Communications Standards Association.

Having served as the Deputy Director-General of Department of Science and Technology in the former Ministry of Information Industry and the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology, Mr.ZHANG has long been engaged in the management of information and communications technology standardization, intellectual property rights and science & technology development, coordination of R& D and application of software and standards, including AVS, IPTV and WAPI. He has been involved in the organization and coordination of activities relating to the R&D and application of TD-SCDMA 3-G mobile communications standard.

Mr.ZHANG has wide experience in Internet regulatory field in relation to basic resources management, technology standardization, development policy and etc. He was also responsible for providing advices on the Internet domain name management in China, which includes domain name registration and assignment, domain name system security, and etc.
