This letter is to confirm in accordance with the <u>Binding Letter of Intent (LOI)</u> between the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) organization (org) and Verisign, Inc. dated 27 March 2020, that ICANN org incurred costs in excess of US\$4 million conducting security, stability and resiliency activities during the period of January through December 2022.
