Dear Paul,

Thank you for your letter of 9 November 2015 to Steve Crocker regarding GAC's Dublin communique and the release of 2-letter labels. Your letter has been posted to ICANN's correspondence page¹.

In its 3 February 2016 meeting the Board adopted a scorecard² responding to and addressing the corresponding GAC advice. The Board expressed concerns with the GAC advice, noting that the process for evaluating comments states that the standard established in the registry agreement is confusion with the corresponding country code and that comments will be evaluated against such standard. The board furthermore stated that all comments will be reviewed and considered by ICANN in determining whether to authorize the release of requested Letter/Letter Two-Character ASCII Labels. The Board appreciates the input from the registry stakeholder group which was considered in developing the scorecard.

As you are aware, on 26 February 2016 ICANN staff published an update to the Authorization Process for the Release of Two-Character ASCII Labels³, asking the relevant registry operators to provide their mitigation plans to ICANN within 60 days. ICANN staff will summarize and aggregate the proposed plans and solicit public comments toward the implementation of the follow on steps, as per the published process.
