Pursuant to Article XI, Section 2.1.j of the ICANN Bylaws, this letter is to formally notify the Government Advisory Committee (GAC) that the Generic Names Supporting Organization (GNSO) Council has approved all the consensus recommendations developed during the Policy Development Process (PDP) by the Working Group on Privacy and Proxy Services Accreditation Issues.
