As described in the Change Review Process – gTLD Applicant Guidebook, Section C (http://www.icann.org/en/topics/new-gtlds/change-review-applicant-guidebook-19sep11en.pdf), changes to the Applicant Guidebook may be authorized by the ICANN Board of Directors. ICANN has also asked for public input on batching on two separate occasions.
