**RE: NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT**

Dear Mr. Parker:

Please be advised that Ynot Domains Corp. ("Ynot Domains") Registrar Accreditation Agreement ("RAA") with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 24 April 2010 ("RAA") is terminated pursuant to Section 5.3.4 of the RAA. The termination shall become effective 20 September 2012, 30 days from the date of this notice.

The termination is due to Ynot Domains' failure to timely cure the breaches by 3 August 2012 as set forth in ICANN's notice of breach of RAA dated 13 July 2012 <http://www.icann.org/en/news/correspondence/burnette-to-parker-13jul12-en.pdf>  
As of 19 August 2012, the following breaches remain:

1. Failure to escrow gTLD registration data pursuant to Section 3.6 of the RAA; and
2. Failure to pay past due accreditation fees pursuant to Section 3.9 of the RAA.

Please see the chronology below for additional details.

Ynot Domains is further advised that the logo license Appendix to the RAA is revoked as of 20 September 2012. Please remove all ICANN trademarks, name and logo from Ynot Domains' website and business materials that have been licensed to Ynot Domains under the terms of that Appendix by 20 September 2012. In addition, please pay the outstanding accreditation fees totaling \$3,807.24 immediately.

### Domain Name Transition Process

To protect domain name registrants, ICANN will commence the domain name transition process and will solicit bids for a qualified ICANN-accredited registrar to manage the domain names currently managed by Ynot Domains.

ICANN will follow the De-Accredited Registrar Transition Procedure "Procedure" <http://www.icann.org/en/processes/registrars/de-accredited-registrar-transition-procedure-01oct08.pdf> . Consistent with the Procedure, please designate a bulk transfer recipient by 27 August 2012 and inform ICANN's Registrar Liaison Team at [RegTransition@icann.org](mailto:RegTransition@icann.org).

Please note that those rights and obligations required or purporting to have effect after expiration of the RAA, including, without limitation, those arising under Sections 3.4, 3.9, 5.6 and 5.7 will survive. Accordingly, Ynot Domains must pay ICANN any accreditation fees owed by it under Section 3.9 and any enforcement costs under Section 5.7 of the RAA. ICANN reserves all its rights under the RAA.
