Your comments and feedback regarding the ongoing Review of the At-Large Organization, together with other relevant communications and submissions to the <u>public comment forum</u>, will be consolidated in a summary report "ICANN Organization Report of Public Comment Proceeding," and subsequently considered by the ICANN Board as an integral part of ICANN's established organizational review process. In line with ICANN's public comment proceedings and practices, the summary of all submitted public comments will be posted on the public comment <u>page</u> by 7 April.

For organizational reviews, the Board considers the Independent Examiner's Final Report alongside the Working Party assessment, public comments and other relevant communications. For the purposes of the At Large review, the Board's decision on appropriate action to take on the Final Report will be based on the issues and recommendations identified and proposed by the Independent Examiner, and the views, explanations, and rationale brought forward in response by the At-Large Review Working Party and other relevant ICANN stakeholders, such as the ALAC, the RALOs, and ICANN's Supporting Organizations and Advisory Committees.
