Thank you for your Request for Information dated 24 October 2016 (Request), which was submitted through the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) Documentary Information Disclosure Policy (DIDP) on behalf of The Centre for Internet & Society (CIS) on 24 October 2016. ### Items Requested

Your Request seeks the disclosure of “copies of all speeches and statements made by Goran Marby since his appointment as ICANN President and CEO in February 2016.”

### Response
