

Dear Registry Operator,

The voting period for proposed global amendment to the base generic top-level domain (gTLD) Registry Agreement (Base RA Global Amendment) concluded on 8 December 2023, and the Base RA Global Amendment has received the required Registry Operator Approval, as per section 7.6(j)(ii) of the Base RA.

Attached is a certificate with the verified, final results. The <u>2024 Global Amendment webpage</u> will be updated shortly with an overview of the final voting results and further details.

As a reminder, now that the vote has closed, the proposed Base RA Global Amendment will be shared with the ICANN Board for consideration, which we expect to occur at the next Board workshop in January 2024. If approval is obtained, the Base RA Global Amendment shall be effective and deemed an Approved Amendment to the Base RA, following a 60-day notice from ICANN. If the Global Amendments are not approved, they will go back to the negotiating teams to discuss next steps.

Thank you for your continued support and participation in the ICANN multi-stakeholder model.
