## All parties involved in the development of this model:

Amongst the 1000+ members of eco, there are some 150 companies active in the domain industry. Drafts of the model have been sent to these members for feedback, which has been incorporated into the paper.

Further, the model has been shared with the RySG and RrSG. Both the RySG as well as the RrSG support submitting the eco GDPR Domain Industry Playbook to ICANN. However, further discussion needs to take place in these groups. They believe the Playbook is a viable baseline and look forward to additional debate.

The following companies have agreed to be mentioned as parties that have been involved in the development of the model and / or they have provided input into the development of the model. The companies listed support the submission of the proposal, but certain aspects need further discussion. The mentioning of the companies shall not be construed as formal endorsement of all aspects of the model.
