Dear Messrs. Marby and Jeffrey,

On behalf of LegitScript LLC, I respectfully request that ICANN allow for an additional 14 days for the community to respond and consider both the interim GDPR models proposed by ICANN and the proposals and models contributed by community participants.

The time period allotted for comment is simply too short for meaningful understanding, consideration, analysis and feedback from the ICANN community.

While LegitScript understands that the period for implementation is short, I ask that the deadline for comments be extended until February 14, 2018.

Extension of the comment period will give the ICANN and the community enough time to make implementation recommendations that meet compliance requirements, minimize resources for implementation, and, potentially enjoy broader community support.
