The removal of Registrant Name, Email, Phone Number and Street Address fields from the publicly available data set does make sense to be GDPR compliant.

This, however, will increase the cybercriminal use of domain names! It is still important that companies, such as Domaintools, or other online monitoring service provider, such as us, are able to identify the registrant's name, email address, Tel. Number can be obtained.

Hope this will be made available thru certain identification rules.
