Dear Sirs,

how could we as a registrar obtain a working FOA email address if a web form is published in the WHOIS? Another problem is, that an anonymized e-mail address requires a huge setup of an e-mail appliance. This must be an infrastructure, which handles millions of e-mails per day, it must not use spam protection (all e-mails must be forwarded, and what happens to bounces?) since there is no service agreement including any e-mail processing by the registrar.

My suggestions would be, that registrars also belong to the group having access to the private WHOIS, to obtain a valid FOA email address.

Another question is: How can a domain holder verify his registrant data at the registry?
