Thank you for contacting the ICANN.

In December 2017, we published a webpage (<https://www.icann.org/resources/pages/gdpr-proposed-models-guidelines-2017-12-08-en>) outlining ICANN's instructions to submit proposed models. It includes a cover page as well as an explanation of what to include within the submission. Once submitted, we will post the proposed model on ICANN's GDPR Legal Analysis Page (<https://www.icann.org/resources/pages/gdpr-legal-analysis-2017-11-17-en>).

Please see ICANN's direct responses to your questions below:

A) May joint submission by a group of Registries for a group of TLDs be acceptable?

ICANN response: Yes, please indicate the members of your group in the cover page (<https://www.icann.org/en/system/files/files/gdpr-proposed-models-cover-page-08dec17-en.pdf>) we've provided. This cover page is available on the Guidelines for Proposed Models to Address the GDPR webpage (noted above) under the section titled "Requirements for Submissions".

B) Is there any specific form for such submission?

ICANN response: Yes, please see the same cover page as mentioned above.

C) It should be an operational, technical and/or legal description?

ICANN response: From the same webpage, please see the section titled "Details of the Proposal".

D) Should be in an explanatory form, or should be as a proposed amendment to Schedule 4 of the Registry Agreements?

ICANN response: Please submit in explanatory form. If you wish to do so, you may also provide a proposed amendment to any necessary section(s) of applicable contracts (i.e. Registry Agreement, Registrar Accreditation Agreement, etc.).

E) What is the deadline for submission?

ICANN response: ICANN is publishing the models as they come in. As indicated in the blog post by Göran Marby, President and CEO of ICANN, on 21 December 2017 (<https://www.icann.org/news/blog/data-protection-and-privacy-update-plans-for-the-new-year>), ICANN's goal is to solicit public feedback on the various compliance models in mid-January. To maximize the opportunity to get community feedback about the models we plan to publish, the earlier we can receive them the better, as they will help inform the ongoing discussion.
