

Short Bio (September 2010)

Professor Hartmut Richard Glaser is the Executive Director/CEO of the Brazilian Internet Steering Committee - CGI.br in Brazil, an “multistakeholder” body, with following responsibilities:

- **To coordinate the allocation of Internet addresses (IPs) and registration of domain names for ccTLD <.br>;**
- **To recommend standards for technical and operational procedures for the Internet in Brazil;**
- **To establish strategic directives related to the use and development of the Internet in Brazil;**
- **To promote studies and technical standards for network and service security in the country;**
- **To collect, organize and disseminate information on Internet services, including indicators and statistics;**
- **To coordinate the Brazilian National Computer Emergency Response Team (CERT), responsible for handling computer security incident reports and activity related to networks connected to the Brazilian Internet;**
- **To coordinate the Center of Study and Research in Network Technology and Operations, responsible for services and projects that aim to improve the quality of the Internet in Brazil, working more specifically with Internet infrastructure, which includes the operation of 12 Internet Exchange Points in Brazil;**
- **To coordinate the W3C Office in Brasil.**
