 - Timeline for Development of a Project for the Technical Test of Internationalized Top Level Labels : March 2006
 - <http://icann.org/announcements/announcement-14mar06.htm>
 - **19-23 March 2006:** An initial presentation introduction was made to the SSAC and RSAC.
 - **April 2006:** Project plan for the technical test of internationalized labels will be released for public review and commentary.
 - **April - May 2006:** One-month public comment period.
 - **May 2006:** Comments will be reviewed by PAC and (revised) project plan will be sent to ICANN Board.
 - **June 2006:** PAC will submit the final plan to the ICANN staff and Board with recommendation to implement the project.
 - **June 2006:** Implementation of the project will be judged no later than the ICANN meeting in Marrakesh (26-30 June 2006).
 - **July 2006:** Request for applications for participation in the technical test will be announced.

IDN-related groups within ICANN

- Working group for the revision of the IDN Guidelines
 - formed in late August, 2005
 - to propose guidelines for registries
 - mandate for gTLD registries
 - expected to be more general - applicable to ccTLDs and IDN labels on 3rd and further levels in domain name structure
 - Reviewed by IDN-PAC, public commentary, further revised as needed - and endorsed by the Board
 - very small group (3 gTLD and 2 ccTLD registries + ICANN staff)
- President's Advisory Committee for IDNs (IDN-PAC)
 - formed in late December, 2005
 - about 20 members from various backgrounds
 - to identify issues and propose solutions to the following main areas
 - IDN TLD
 - IDN Technical Development
 - IDN Policy

Recent Topics (1)

- Introduction of IDN Top Level Labels
 - issues
 - Technical issues
 - Policy issues
 - discussion being held in IDN-PAC (President's Advisory Committee)
 - steps of introduction
 - Discussion of technical and policy issues in parallel? ---> Yes
 - ccTLDs first, then gTLDs? ---> ???
 - Whether ASCII-TLD and IDN-TLD are equivalent spaces or not ---> ???
 - Technical test plan was published on ICANN website
 - Details are still under discussion
 - Initial input to public, SSAC, and RSSAC for feedback
 - During Dallas IETF meeting (March 2006)

Recent Topics (2)

- IDN technical issues
 - revision of the IDN guidelines as needed
 - Reframing of the guidelines into BCP (in the IETF field)
 - security (e.g., anti-phishing)
- IDN policy issues
 - Language/script table development for languages/scripts
 - reserved domain names (e.g., government office names, geographical names)
 - trademarks protection (considering transliteration and translation)

Recent Topics (3)

- Application software
 - Readiness
 - Browsers
 - Many popular browsers are already IDN-enabled
 - Internet Explorer 7 with IDN capability is coming later this year
 - e-mails
 - March 2006: IETF WG established
 - Investigation, I-D drafting, and discussion under way
 - March 2007: WG re-chartered for standards track
