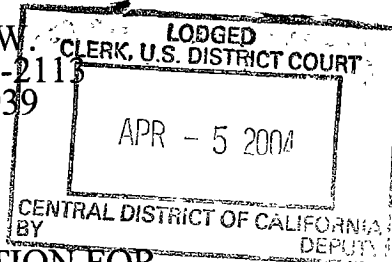

GRANTING DEFENDANT  
INTERNET CORPORATION  
FOR ASSIGNED NAMES AND  
NUMBERS' MOTION TO  
DISMISS THE COMPLAINT  
PURSUANT TO RULE 12(B)(6)  
OF THE FEDERAL RULES OF  
CIVIL PROCEDURE**

Motion and Motion to Dismiss and  
Request for Judicial Notice]

1 This Court, having read and considered the papers submitted by the parties,  
2 and finding good cause therefor, orders that the motion to dismiss pursuant to  
3 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure section 12(b)(6) filed by defendant Internet  
4 Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers is hereby SUSTAINED without  
5 leave to amend as to plaintiff VeriSign, Inc.'s ("VeriSign") first claim for relief for  
6 violation of section 1 of the Sherman Act, second claim for relief for injunctive  
7 relief for breach of contract, third claim for relief for damages for breach of  
8 contract, fourth claim for relief for interference with contractual relations, fifth  
9 claim for relief for specific performance of contract and injunctive relief, and sixth  
10 claim for relief for damages for breach of contract. VeriSign's first, second, third,  
11 fourth, fifth, and sixth causes of action are hereby dismissed with prejudice because  
12 none of these claims for relief states a claim upon which relief may be granted.
