Re: Proposal #2007003, DNS Update Service

Gentlemen,


This letter is to inform you that ICANN has completed its review of VeriSign's request to offer the DNS Update Service, proposal #2007003, pursuant to the Registry Agreement between VeriSign and ICANN dated effective 1 March 2006.

On 22 March 2007, VeriSign submitted a proposal to ICANN for a "DNS Update Service" to be used by registrars and other entities that request zone file access in the .COM and .NET TLDs. The proposal states that VeriSign has received interest from a number of registrars, brand monitoring, fraud protection and anti-phishing companies to create a service providing a report of changes to the rapid zone updates for the .COM and .NET TLD zone files.

On 5 April 2007, VeriSign and ICANN mutually agreed to postpone the deadline for the preliminary determination until today, 11 April 2007.

After seeking expert advice throughout the prescribed and extended "preliminary determination" period, ICANN has determined that the proposed DNS Update Service does not appear to raise significant Security or Stability, or competition issues.
