Subject: Launch of Naming Services portal enhancement to support Centralized Zone Data Service



Dear Colleagues,

Today, **28 January 2019**, the ICANN organization released an update to the Centralized Zone Data Service (CZDS), which incorporates CZDS registry operator functionality into the Naming Services portal.

As we've shared in previous communications, you must now access CZDS by navigating to <https://portal.icann.org/>. If you have credentials to the Naming Services portal or have recently received a Naming Services portal activation email, you may begin using the CZDS service immediately. Please note that all existing CZDS registry user accounts have been deleted from the legacy portal and no further action is required by you.

CZDS Notifications

CZDS can be configured to notify you via email each time an end-user access request is received for any TLD that you are authorized to manage in the Naming Services portal. The initial configuration for CZDS notifications has been set to OFF to avoid potentially unwanted notifications being sent to all users. You can request that CZDS notifications be turned ON for yourself and any other users on your account by contacting Global Support at the below email address.
