## Net 4 India Limited – Summary of Proceedings and Orally-Issued Court Orders (27 April 2021)

Summary of Proceedings and Orally-Issued Court Orders through 19 March 2021 is available here.

Since 19 March 2021, the following has occurred in the Net 4 India Limited (Net 4 India) matter.

On 23 March 2021, ICANN appeared before the Court and provided further <u>written submissions</u> to demonstrate the harm being suffered by registrants as a result of Net 4 India's actions, and also to request that the Court issue its final determination as soon as possible.

On 18 April 2021, ICANN org filed an <u>additional written submission</u> with the Court, this time explaining: (i) that in the days immediately prior, some (or all) of Net 4 India's nameservers completely ceased to operate, resulting in thousands of Net 4 India customers losing access to their websites; and (ii) the impact on India as a result of Net 4 India's actions (given that several of the recent complaints were submitted by public utilities, major corporations, financial services, members of the judiciary, and health-related services in India). On 20 April 2021, ICANN appeared before the Court to further emphasize the gravity of the situation and request that the Court vacate the Ad-Interim Order. Appreciating the urgency of the matter, the Court scheduled a hearing for 27 April 2021.

On 27 April 2021, the Court held a hearing and, after considering the latest submissions, orally issued an order vacating the Ad-Interim Order, thereby leaving ICANN free to give effect to the termination of Net 4 India's Registrar Accreditation Agreement (RAA).

ICANN org is moving forward with the termination and transfer process; and is initiating the <u>De-Accredited Registrar Transition Procedure</u> (DARTP), which will allow ICANN to transfer the registrations currently under Net 4 India's management to an ICANN-accredited registrar in good standing. Once a gaining registrar is identified and confirmed, it will then be listed on the <u>Bulk Transfers page</u>.
