PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Pursuant to Federal Rule of Evidence 201, Plaintiff DOTCONNECTAFRICA TRUST ("DCA") hereby requests the Court take judicial notice of the following documents, attached as Exhibits 1–3, in support of DCA's Opposition to Defendant ZA Central Registry, NPC'S ("ZACR") Motion to Dismiss First Amended Complaint:

1. The New gTLD Applicant Guidebook ("Guidebook"), a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

2. Contract SA 1301-12-CN-0035, between ICANN and the U.S. Department of Commerce, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**.

3. Webpage printout of website titled: "What is dotAfrica?" accessible at: <u>http://africainonespace.org/content.php?tag=5&title=What+is+dotAfrica%3F</u>. A true and correct copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

When ruling on a 12(b)(6) motion, a court may look beyond the pleadings "at documents incorporated by reference, and matters of which a court may take judicial notice." *Tellabs, Inc. v. Makor Issues & Rights, Ltd.*, 127 S. Ct. 2499, 2509 (2007).

Under the incorporation by reference doctrine, a court may consider a document when plaintiff's complaint necessarily relies on it and its authenticity is uncontested. *Van Buskirk v. CNN*, 284 F.3d 977, 980 (9th Cir. 2002); *see also In re Silicon Graphics, Inc. Sec. Litig.*, 183 F.3d 970, 986 (9th Cir. 1999). This includes documents that are not attached or explicitly referenced by plaintiff's complaint. *Neilson v. Union Bank of Cal.*, *N.A.*, 290 F. Supp. 2d 1101, 1114 (C.D. Cal. 2003).

Under Federal Rule of Evidence 201, judicial notice is proper when a fact is not subject to reasonable dispute and capable of accurate and ready determination by resort to sources whose accuracy cannot reasonably be questioned. *Wible v. Aetna Life Ins. Co.*, 375 F. Supp. 2d 956, 966 (C.D. Cal. 2005); Fed. R. Evid. 201. Judicial notice of information obtained from a website is proper when neither party questions the authenticity of the site. *Pollstar v. Gigmania Ltd.*, 170 F. Supp. 2d
974, 978 (E.D. Cal. 2000). A Court may take judicial notice of a matter of public
record. *Moore v. Navarro*, 2004 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 6039, *5 (N.D. Cal. Mar. 31,
2004.)

The New gTLD Applicant Guidebook and Modules (Exhibit 1)

The Guidebook and Modules are referenced and relied on throughout Plaintiff's FAC. (*See, e.g.*, FAC ¶¶ 20, 22, 25, 66, 74.) ZACR has also requested the Court take judicial notice of Module 6 of the Guidebook (*See* Defendant's RJN.) In its RJN ZACR agrees that at least as to module 6 "there is no dispute as to the authenticity." (*Id.* at 3:27-28). Finally, the Guidebook is available on ICANN's website at https://newgtlds.icann.org/en/applicants/agb.

Contract SA 1301-12-CN-0035 (Exhibit 2)

On a Rule 12(b)(6) motion, the Court may take judicial notice of matters of public record. Moore v. Navarro, 2004 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 6039, *5 (N.D. Cal. Mar. 31, 2004.) The contract is a public record as it is available on the U.S. Department of Commerce's website at: https://www.ntia.doc.gov/files/ntia/publications/ sf 26 pg 1-2-final award and sacs.pdf. "What is dotAfrica?" Webpage (Exhibit 3)

The webpage comes directly from ZACR's own website. "A court must take judicial notice if a party requests it and supplies the court with the requisite information. 'A judicially noticed fact must be one not subject to a reasonable dispute in that it is either (1) generally known within the territorial jurisdiction of the trial court or (2) capable of accurate and ready determination by resort to sources whose accuracy cannot reasonably be questioned."' *Wible v. Aetna Life Ins. Co.*, 37 F.Supp.2d 956, 966 (C.D. Cal. 2005) [granting request for judicial notice as to webpage of American Academy of Allgery Asthma & Immunology]. Furthermore, DCA does not request judicial notice for the truth of the statements contained in the
webpage, but rather to show that the statements were made. *See e.g. Farah v. Esquire Magazine, Inc.*, 863 F.Supp.2d 29, 35 (D.C.C. 2012). Webpage accessible
