Proposed Governance Model for DNS Root Server System

On 15 June, the Root Server System Advisory Committee (RSSAC) published two documents.

RSSAC037 presents a governance model for the Domain Name System (DNS) Root Server System (RSS) and its Root Server Operators. This model is the result of three years of extensive deliberations by the RSSAC to address the issues of accountability, financial stability, and sustainability of the RSS.

RSSAC038 is a companion document to RSSAC037 and contains three recommendations to further develop and implement the model presented in RSSAC037.

An Important Month for the Latin American and Caribbean Region

LAC Internet pioneers have attracted and engaged new voices to these policy discussions - both in the region and around the world. In June, the Latin American and Caribbean (LAC) region was at the epicenter of the Internet community's policy development processes. Events such as the LAC-i-Roadshow and the celebration of 20 years of the Latin American and Caribbean Country Code Top-Level Domain Association (LACTLD) proved that this region is actively participating in ICANN's processes. June came to a close at ICANN62 in Panama City, the first Policy Forum held in the LAC region.



A Review of the Middle East DNS Forum: Five Years and Counting

When the Middle East Domain Name System (DNS) Forum reached its five-year milestone, a community survey was sent to previous participants, as well as the broader Middle East community, on 23 May 2018. The survey is aimed at assessing whether the forum has succeeded in addressing the concerns laid out by the ICANN's regional strategy, which was published back in 2013.

Proposal for Generation Panel for Myanmar Script Label Generation Ruleset for the Root Zone

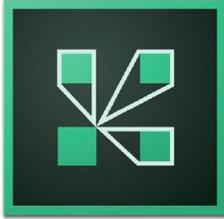
On 28 June, ICANN announced the formation of the Generation Panel to develop root zone Label Generation Rules (LGR) for the Myanmar script.

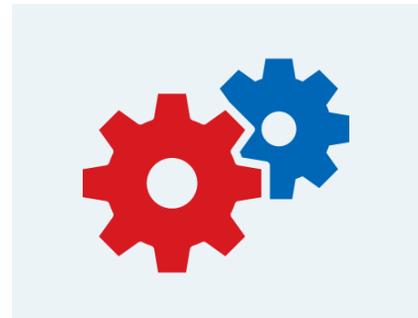

- Collecting and analyzing data to prepare stakeholders for the upcoming root zone Key Signing Key (KSK) rollover.
- Studying and measuring components of the Domain Name System (DNS).

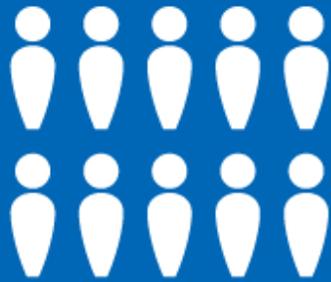
