Oksana Prykhodko is Ukrainian journalist, media expert, civil society activist. She is the Director of European Media Platform which is an international NGO consulting on the practical implementation of European standards in the sphere of media and information. She is also the secretary of EURALO.

In Internet Governance issues Oksana Prykhodko became involved since 2006, when she as a journalist covered First IGF in Athenes (on the invitation of the Council of Europe). She participated in the Council of Europe Group of Experts on human rights in informational society, graduated EuroSSIG, DiploFoundation's European Internet Governance Capacity Building Program, participated in ICANN Fellowship Program.

Oksana Prykhodko was the catalyst of EuroDIG remote participation hub in Ukraine (2010), co-organizer of IGF-UA (2010, 2011, 2012), organizer of the Forum “Media for Information Society” (2012). She also organized workshops at EuroDIG and IGF, was invited to the Russian IGF (2011).

Oksana Prykhodko also organized some round tables in Ukrainian parliament (on media and information society issues). She is the member of AI-Large Councils at the Ukrainian Broadcasting Council and Ukrainian Commission on communications and informatization (national independent regulators). Oksana Prykhodko participated in the Working Group on the new draft of law on audio-visual services, in Consulting Committee on Ukrainian domains administration.

She was the community representative in IDN Variant Case Study Working Group, participated in ICANN Academy and Capacity Building Working Groups. She is also administrator of ISOC Ukraine Chapter initiative Group.

The main spheres of her interests are the understanding of the concept of multistakeholderism in quazi-democratic and authoritarian countries (especially in post-Soviet Russian-speaking community), awareness raising and capacity building.
