I am working at the Swedish Post and Telecom Agency which is the authority in Sweden responsible for electronic communication including the Internet. My ordinary day-to-day work involves taking measures for improved robustness and resilience in public electronic networks including the DNS and provision of traceable time UTC. This work is done in cooperation with ISPs, DNS-operators, Top Level domain registries, WiFi providers, mobile operators and suppliers of electrical power. These stakeholders also take part in emergency exercises planned and carried out by us in a spirit of public private partnership together with involved parties. I also personally have worked with promotion of the deployment of DNSSEC as well as proactive adoption of IPv6 in Sweden. The agency has implemented both standards in its Internet environment which means that the domain pts.se is signed and the web site [www.pts.se](http://www.pts.se) is connected with both IPv4 and IPv6 to the Internet dual stack. A also use to support my colleague supervising electronic communication and the Swedish Top Level domain in matters regarding technology and threats to robustness and security.

I look forward to participating in the review team for preserving security, stability and resiliency of the DNS.
