In the next few hours, you will receive an invitation to vote from a secure online voting platform. The email will be sent from noreply@eballot.com.

ICANN organization (org) is requesting your vote on the approval of the <u>proposed global</u> <u>amendment (Global Amendment) to the 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement</u> (RAA) to enhance the existing provisions in Section 3.18 of the RAA by requiring registrars to promptly take reasonable and appropriate action to stop or otherwise disrupt DNS Abuse. Voting options:

Registrars representing over 90% of total registered domains under management must vote "Yes" to achieve Registrar Approval for this proposed Global Amendment, so every vote matters.

Voting closes at 23:59 UTC on 8 December 2023.
