Section I: General Overview and Next Steps

This Public Comment proceeding seeks to obtain input on the Initial Report of the Phase 2 EPDP on the Temporary Specification for gTLD Registration Data Team. The Phase 2 EPDP Team is tasked with evaluating a System for Standardized Access/Disclosure to non-public gTLD registration data ("SSAD"). The Initial Report outlines the core issues discussed, proposed responses to charter questions, and accompanying preliminary recommendations.

The EPDP Team also sought specific guidance with respect to Recommendation 19 (Mechanism for the evolution of SSAD) and SSAD reporting requirements, asking:

- What existing processes / procedures, if any, can be used to meet the above [criteria]?
- If no suitable existing processes / procedures can be used, what type of mechanism should be created factoring in: Who should guidance be provided to? How is guidance developed / agreed to? How should it be structured?
- What information is needed to ensure the continuous evolution of SSAD?
- How is guidance of the Mechanism expected to be implemented?
- What type of reporting should be required as part of SSAD?

The EPDP Team is now carefully reviewing Community input and will consider it when developing final responses to charter questions, final recommendations, and implementation guidance in its Final Report. The EPDP Team will submit its Final Report to the GNSO Council for its consideration. Following approval by the GNSO, the GNSO Council will submit the Final Report to the ICANN Board for its consideration.
