ICANN org is pleased to announce the launch of operational improvements to the Registry Services Evaluation Policy (RSEP) request process. These changes are the result of collaboration with the gTLD Registries Stakeholder Group (RySG) to improve the efficiency and predictability of the process for reviewing registry operator requests under the RSEP.
