Keith Drazek: (21:26) I am happy to contribute to the review.

Bladel: (21:41) That's the CWG-Accountability co-chairs.

Keith Drazek: (21:44) The CCWG Accountability will work closely with the CWG Transition to ensure the processes are in sync and complementary. But the ICG is only focused on the proposal to be submitted by the CWG Transition. The Accountability CCWG is a parallel process, but does not feed directly into the ICG. Rather, it will feed WS1 input into the ICG via the CWG Transition.

Bladel: (21:45) +1 Keith.

Keith Drazek: (21:46) The CCWG Accountability will not submit anything directly to the ICG. It will submit its recommendation directly to the ICANN Board and to NTIA.

Keith Drazek: (21:48) The ICG and CWG Accountability are focused only on the IANA Functions Stewardship Transition and engaging the operational communities on their needs for the IANA Functions Stewardship transtion specifically. The Accountability CCWG is much broader in scope and not in the remit of the ICG. That said, the CCWG Accountability and CWG Transition WILL work closely together to address any broader accountability issues/reforms that are necessary for the IANA Functions transition.

Keith Drazek: (21:49) The Co-Chairs of the CCWG Accountability and CWG Transition are already in contact.

Wolf-Ulrich Knoben: (21:54) @James: good suggestion

Lynn St.Amour: (21:55) @Keith, what "review/work" would you see for the ICG for the Accountability work?

Jean-Jacques Subrenat: (21:56) "vite fait, mal fait" (Kavouss quoted) Lynn St.Amour: (21:56) @Keith: feel free to respond by voice:-)

Keith Drazek: (21:56) This process has been bifurcated by ICANN from the beginning. I agree it's a mess, but that's the hand we've been dealt. The ICG is ONLY focusing on the IANA FUNCTIONS Stewardship proposals. The WS-1 Accountability issues are being handled separately, but will feed into the CWG Transition work.

Bladel: (21:57) Kavouss raises an important point about comments. That's probably a minimum of 4 weeks -after- the report is published.

Wolf-Ulrich Knoben: (21:57) all IANA related accountability items are in workstream 1. If both CWG and CCWG are contributing to this the ICG will have to coordinate

Jari Arkko: (21:58) Keith - I believe it is very important that the IANA-related accountability aspects (WS-1) are fed into the CWG, and eventually into the ICG. I do not think we need any direct input from CCWG. But we do need an accountability story from all operational communities, including names.

Keith Drazek: (21:58) @Lynn: The ICG should review any WS-1 accountability

work that is submitted by the CWG Transition, following the interaction between those two groups.

Jari Arkko: (21:58) so, if i understand you right, we're good, if the WS-1 work is channeled through CWG

Keith Drazek: (21:59) Correct, it just means the CWG submission is dependent upon the CCWG work that is unfortunately behind.

Wolf-Ulrich Knoben: (21:59) Yes Keith. But if the ICG timeline is affected we should know about

Thomas Schneider: (22:00) I have to leave for another GAC call. Looking forward to seeing you in Singapore... Best Thomas

Lynn St.Amour: (22:00) @Keith, thanks -- that is more clear and if you support what Alissa is saying then we may all be aligned...

Keith Drazek: (22:00) Correct. It will be affected and it's up to the CWG Transition to advise the ICG of the necessary extension or timeline to accomplish its work. I believe they are preparing to do so.
