ICANN has conducted a preliminary review of Universal Postal Union's request for Release and allocation of previously-reserved IANA strings to second- and higher-level .post sTLD registrations, in accordance with the Registry Services Evaluation Policy and process set forth at <http://www.icann.org/registries/rsep/rsep.html>.

Based on the information provided, ICANN's preliminary review did not identify any significant competition, security or stability issues. As noted in the proposal, implementation requires a modification to the .post TLD Sponsorship Agreement signed 11 December 2009. Please send us your proposed Registry Agreement amendment in editable format. We will get back to you as soon as possible with details on the process for consideration of the proposed amendment and with any comments we might have on the text of the proposed amendment.
