Purpose of AF

- need something that shows
 - what ICANN/IANA does for each ccTLD
 - what each ccTLD does for global internet
- current ccTLD sponsorship agreement template
 - heavy
 - liability rather than commitment
- AF
 - lighter : eg. a few pages
 - for ICANN and ccTLD to ensure global interoperability/stability/security/... of the internet
 - what ICANN/IANA commits for ccTLD
 - what ccTLD commits for global internet

What ccNSO will do

- · develop and document "AF guidelines"
 - guidelines
 - best practices
 - minimum criteria
- discuss with ICANN especially about "what ICANN commits" part

so that

- each ccTLD can develop its own AF when it negotiates terms&conditions in making agreement with ICANN
- each ccTLD can refer to "AF guidelines" when it develops its code of conduct

What "AF guidelines" is not

- not a policy
 - PDP is not used to develop consensus
 - AF is not such thing that Board approves
- not binding
- not an ICANN sponsorship contract template
- not directly related to delegation/redelegation of each ccTLD

Schedule

- phase1 : Sept/2004-Feb/2005
 - share ideas what AF is / what ccNSO does
 - analyze existing documents
- plase2 : Mar/2005-Aug/2005
 - discuss, develop and document "AF guidelines" with necessary interaction with ICANN staffs
- phase3 (not be done by WG)
 - everlasting revisit/maintain AF document periodically

Working Method

- every phase has several cycles of
 - WG discussion
 - ccNSO discussion
 - ccTLD discussion
 - public consultant
- discussion and consultant are through meetings on the internet, such as online-meeting and mailing lists
- physical meetings along with ccNSO meetings are used as supplementary
