Verisign Registry .Name Monthly Report – September 2012

As required by the ICANN/Verisign Registry Agreement dated 15 August 2007 (Section 3.1(c)(iv)), this report provides an overview of Registry activity through the end of the reporting month. The information is presented in table format with text explanations as deemed necessary. **The information is provided to satisfy requirements listed in Appendix 4 of the .name Registry Agreement.** Pursuant to the agreement, "ICANN shall use reasonable commercial efforts to preserve the confidentiality of the information reported until three months after the end of the month to which the report relates".

1 – Accredited Registrar Status (Appendix 4, Item 1)

Table 1 states the number of Registrars for whom Verisign has received accreditation notification from ICANN at the end of the reporting month, grouped into the three categories:

1. Operational Registrars: Those who have authorized access into the Shared Registration System (SRS) for processing domain name registrations.
2. Registrars In The Ramp-Up Period: Those who have received a password to access the Registry operational test and evaluation (OT&E) environment. The OT&E environment is provided to allow registrars to develop and test their systems with the SRS.
3. Registrars In The Pre-Ramp-Up Period: Those who have been sent a welcome letter from Verisign but have not yet executed the Registry Registrar Agreements and/or have not yet submitted a completed Registrar Information Sheet. In most cases registrars are sent welcome letters via overnight express mail or e-mail on the same day accreditation notification is received from ICANN.

2 – Service Level Agreement Performance (Appendix 4, Item 2)

As required by the Registry Agreement, Verisign is committed to provide service levels as specified in Appendix 7 and to comply with the requirements of the SLA in Appendix 10 of the Registry Agreement. The SLA is incorporated into the Verisign Registry/Registrar Agreement that is executed with all operational registrars. Note: The SLA permits two 12-hour windows per year to perform major upgrades.
