

Curriculum Vitae of Mr.ZHANG Xinsheng

Mr.ZHANG Xinsheng, [REDACTED] is now the Secretary General of the China Institute of Communications(CIC). He has long experience in ICT technology and development. He served as counsel(Director-General Level) with the Telecommunications Administration Bureau, the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT). And he was Deputy Secretary-General of Communications Science & Technology Commission, MIIT and Deputy Secretary-General of China Communications Standards Association.

Having served as the Deputy Director-General of Department of Science and Technology in the former Ministry of Information Industry and the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology, Mr.ZHANG has long been engaged in the management of information and communications technology standardization, intellectual property rights and science & technology development, coordination of R&D and application of software and standards, including AVS, IPTV and WAPI. He has been involved in the organization and coordination of activities relating to the R&D and application of TD-SCDMA 3G mobile communications standard.

Mr.ZHANG has wide experience in Internet regulatory field in relation to basic resources management, technology standardization, development policy and etc. He was also responsible for providing advices on the policy of Internet domain name management in China, which includes domain name registration and assignment, domain name system security, and etc.

Mr.ZHANG has also been involved in organizing the telecommunications enterprises, research institutes and colleges to participate in the activities of the International Telecommunications Union (ITU), 3GPP, 3GPP2, OMA and other international standardization organizations. He has participated in the ITU World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly (WTSA), ITU World Radiocommunication Conference (WRC), ITU Radiocommunication Assembly (RA),

the Telecommunication Standardization Advisory Group (TSAG) and other international conferences, and took part in the research and discussion of the Telephone Number Mapping (ENUM) relating to ITU-T SG2. Mr.ZHANG was also the Chairman on the Chinese side for the China-Japan-Korea Next Generation Internet Working Group and 3G & Next Generation Mobile Communications Working Group.

Mr.ZHANG graduated ■■■ from Beijing University of Posts and Telecommunications, majoring in radio communications. In 2001, he received master degree in MBA in the Norwegian School of Economics and Business Administration (NHH) and in 2008, he received his DBA degree in Hong Kong Polytechnic University.

Mr.ZHANG served as a member of the first and second Accountability and Transparency Review Team(ATRT1 and ATRT2) in 2010 and 2013. The first ATRT conducted the review on ICANN and put forward 27 recommendations for ICANN to improve its accountability and transparency.
