RE: Request for Exemption from Registry Operator Code of Conduct

PUNTO FA S.L., in connection with the execution of the Registry Agreement for the .mango TLD (the "Registry Agreement"), hereby requests an exemption from the obligations of the Registry Operator Code of Conduct set forth in Specification 9 to the Registry Agreement (the "Code of Conduct"). Pursuant to such request, Registry Operator confirms that each of the following

statements is true and correct.

- 1. All domain name registrations in the TLD are registered to, and maintained by, Registry Operator or its Affiliates for the exclusive use of Registry Operator or its Affiliate (as defined in the Registry Agreement);
- 2. Registry Operator does not sell, distribute or transfer control or use of any registrations in the TLD to any third party that is not an Affiliate of Registry Operator; and
- 3. Application of the Code of Conduct to the TLD is not necessary to protect the public interest. The rationale for the relationship between the applicant, PUNTO FA S.L. and the name of the string, .mango, is, stated in our answer to Question 11 in the application:



MANGO

PUNTO FA S.L. operates in the commercial traffic doing business under the name MANGO. The trademark MANGO is registered in Spain by DIKNAH S.L., wholly owned subsidiary of PUNTO FA S.L. DIKNAH S.L.'s wholly-owned subsidiary CONSOLIDATED ARTISTS B.V. is the owner of MANGO's international trademark, as well as the trademarks registered in many different jurisdictions all over the world. The Directors of PUNTO FA S.L do not hold their position as appointed individuals, but as representatives of the respective companies, as described in their Titles, according to the provisions of the Real Decreto 1784/1996, de 19 de julio, por el que se aprueba el Reglamento del Registro Mercantil.

PUNTO FA S.L. included its intention to request an exemption from the Code of Conduct in its application. As stated in the answer to Question 18 b) (iv):

PUNTO FA S.L. will request the exemption to the above mentioned Registry Operator Code of Conduct, and expects ICANN to grant such exemption as MANGO provides reasonable satisfaction of the conditions hereof expressed. PUNTO FA S.L. may in the future consider extending the use of domain names for employees, customers and partners, but this is not foreseen neither allowed in the current description of the registration policies.

Registry Operator represents that the registration policies attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** are a true and correct copy of the Registry Operator's registration policies for the TLD. Registry Operator agrees that if Registry Operator makes any changes to its registration policies (whether before or after an exemption has been granted), it will promptly provide ICANN with a revised set of registration policies.



Registry Operator acknowledges and agrees that in the event that any of the foregoing Statements becomes untrue (including after ICANN has granted an exemption pursuant to this exemption request), any Code of Conduct exemption granted by ICANN to Registry Operator for the TLD shall immediately expire, and Registry Operator shall (i) immediately notify ICANN specifying in reasonable detail the circumstances causing any of the Statements to be untrue and (ii) immediately comply with the Code of Conduct.

Registry Operator further acknowledges and agrees that ICANN may revoke this exemption at any time based upon evidence reasonably satisfactory to ICANN that the Statements have become untrue. In the event that ICANN provides notice that it has revoked this exemption, Registry Operator shall immediately comply with the Code of Conduct.

Registry Operator hereby acknowledges that the following are the true and correct registration policies for the TLD, as described in the answer to Question 18 b)(iv):

> The .mango TLD will be for the exclusive use of the MANGO's services and purposes. PUNTO FA does not contemplate at this stage opening the registration to any third party. Therefore, the mandatory registration agreement will refer to the following terms and conditions:

- a) Eligibility: The registrant will be PUNTO FA S.L. or any Affiliate.
- b) Name selection: .mango domain name registrations must be related to the MANGO's services and products.
- c) Use and content: mango domain names may only be used in relationship to the MANGO's services and purposes, subject to the approval of PUNTO FA S.L.

Domain names used must be commensurate to the role and portance of the MANGO service
