RE: NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Youzhi Wang,

Please be advised that as of 1 August 2018, Ten Network Technology Limited's ("Ten Network Technology") 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 13 September 2017 ("RAA") is terminated pursuant to Section 5.5.4 of the RAA. The termination shall become effective 31 August 2018, 30 calendar days from the date of this notice.

The termination is due to Ten Network Technology's failure to timely cure the breaches by 31 July 2018 as set forth in ICANN's notice of breach of RAA dated 10 July 2018. As of 1 August 2018, the following breaches remain:

- 1. Ten Network Technology's failure to escrow gTLD registration data, as required by Section 3.6 of the RAA;
- 2. Ten Network Technology's failure to provide an interactive webpage and a port 43 Whois service providing free public query-based access to up-to-date data concerning all active registered names sponsored by Ten Network Technology for each top-level domain ("TLD") in which it is accredited, as required by Section 3.3.1 of the RAA;
- Ten Network Technology's failure to publish on its website(s) and/or provide a link on its website to the Registrants' Benefits and Responsibilities Specification, as required by Section 3.7.10 of the RAA;
- Ten Network Technology's failure to provide and maintain accurate and current information as specified in the Registrar Information Specification ("RIS") and to notify ICANN within five days of any changes to such information, as required by Section 3.17 of the RAA;



- 5. Ten Network Technology's failure to publish an email address to receive abuse reports on the home page of Ten Network Technology's website, as required by Section 3.18.1 of the RAA; and
- 6. Ten Network Technology's failure to publish on its website a description of Ten Network Technology's procedures for the receipt, handling and tracking of abuse reports, as required by Section 3.18.3 of the RAA.

Additionally, Ten Network Technology has failed to do the following:

- 1. Demonstrate compliance with the Whois format requirements by displaying domain name data in the specified response format, as required by Section 1.4 of the Whois Specification, Clarifications and AWIP; and
- 2. Provide ICANN with the corrective and preventative action(s) that Ten Network Technology will take, with implementation date(s), to ensure:
 - a. Ten Network Technology's contact information is timely updated, including in ICANN's RADAR system and the RIS form, as applicable; and
 - b. timely and complete response to ICANN Contractual Compliance matters.

Please see the chronology below for additional details.

Ten Network Technology is further advised that the logo license granted in the Logo License Specification to the RAA is revoked as of 31 August 2018. Please remove all ICANN trademarks, name and logo from Ten Network Technology's website and business materials that have been licensed to Ten Network Technology under the terms of that Specification by 31 August 2018.

Domain Name Transition Process

To protect domain name registrants, ICANN will commence the domain name transition process and will solicit bids for a qualified ICANN-accredited registrar to manage the domain names currently managed by Ten Network Technology.

ICANN will follow the <u>De-Accredited Registrar Transition Procedure</u> ("Procedure"). Consistent with the Procedure, please designate a bulk transfer recipient by 8 August 2018 and inform ICANN's Registrar Liaison Team at <u>RegTransition@icann.org</u>.

ICANN reserves all its rights under the RAA. Please note the rights and obligations required to have effect after the expiration of the RAA, including but not limited to Sections 3.4 Retention of Registered Name Holder and Registration Data, 3.9 Accreditation Fees, 5.8 Resolution of Disputes Under this Agreement, and 5.9 Limitations on Monetary Remedies for Violations of this Agreement.



Ten Network Technology has current due accreditation fees. These fees are required to be paid to ICANN by Section 3.9 of the RAA. Please immediately submit payment to ICANN accounting.
