Dear James Archer,

Please be advised that as of 15 November 2018, NameStream.com, Inc.'s ("NameStream.com") 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 7 August 2014 ("RAA") is terminated pursuant to Section 5.5.4 of the RAA. The termination shall become effective 14 December 2018, 29 calendar days from the date of this notice.

The termination is due to NameStream.com's failure to timely cure the breach by 14 November 2018 as set forth in ICANN's notice of breach of RAA dated 24 October 2018. As of 15 November 2018, the following breaches remain:

- 1. NameStream.com's failure to timely pay past due accreditation fees, as required by Section 3.9 of the RAA; and
- 2. NameStream.com's failure to provide a port 43 Whois service providing free public query-based access to up-to-date data concerning all active registered names sponsored by NameStream.com in any generic top-level domain (gTLD) operating a "thin" registry, as required by Section 3.3.1 of the RAA.

Additionally, NameStream.com has failed to:

- 1. Confirm its display of domain name data in the specified response format, as required by Section 1.4 of the Whois Specification and additional Whois formatting requirements;
- Confirm NameStream.com's compliance with the data escrow requirements of Section 3.6 of the RAA and provide explanation to address the inconsistent number of second level domain names noted in the notice of breach; and



- 3. Provide ICANN with corrective and preventative action(s), including implementation date(s), to ensure that NameStream.com will:
 - a. timely and fully respond to ICANN Contractual Compliance matters; and
 - b. timely make payment of its ICANN fees.

Please see the chronology below for additional details.

NameStream.com is further advised that the logo license granted in the Logo License Specification to the RAA is revoked as of 14 December 2018. Please remove all ICANN trademarks, name and logo from NameStream.com's website and business materials that have been licensed to NameStream.com under the terms of that Specification by 14 December 2018.

Domain Name Transition Process

To protect domain name registrants, ICANN will commence the domain name transition process and will solicit bids for a qualified ICANN-accredited registrar to manage the domain names currently managed by NameStream.com.

ICANN will follow the <u>De-Accredited Registrar Transition Procedure</u> ("Procedure"). Consistent with the Procedure, please designate a bulk transfer recipient by 22 November 2018 and inform ICANN's Registrar Liaison Team at <u>RegTransition@icann.org</u>.

ICANN reserves all its rights under the RAA. Please note the rights and obligations required to have effect after the expiration of the RAA, including but not limited to Sections 3.4 Retention of Registered Name Holder and Registration Data, 3.9 Accreditation Fees, 5.8 Resolution of Disputes Under this Agreement, and 5.9 Limitations on Monetary Remedies for Violations of this Agreement.

NameStream.com has current and past due accreditation fees. These fees are required to be paid to ICANN by Section 3.9 of the RAA. Please immediately submit payment to ICANN accounting.
