RE: NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Vincent Hamm,

Please be advised that as of 3 April 2017, Aim High!, Inc.'s ("Aim High") Registrar Accreditation Agreement ("RAA") with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 30 September 2014 ("RAA") is terminated pursuant to Section 5.5.3 of the RAA. The termination shall become effective 3 May 2017, 30 calendar days from the date of this notice.

The termination is due to Aim High's failure to timely cure the breaches by 31 March 2017 as set forth in ICANN's notice of suspension of RAA dated 6 January 2017. As of 3 April 2017, the following breaches remain:

- 1. Aim High's failure to not knowingly employ an officer that is judged by a court of competent jurisdiction to have committed fraud or breach of fiduciary duty without terminating such officer within thirty (30) days of Aim High's knowledge of the foregoing, as required by Section 5.5.3 of the RAA;
- 2. Aim High's failure to provide and maintain accurate and current information as specified in the Registrar Information Specification ("RIS"), including the required supporting documentation and the location of any applicable information required to be published on Aim High's website, as required by Section 3.17 of the RAA;

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- 3. Aim High's failure to failure to escrow gTLD registration data, as required by Section 3.6 of the RAA;
- 4. Aim High's failure to provide domain name data in the specified response format, as required by Section 1.4 of the Registration Data Directory Service (Whois) Specification of the RAA ("Whois Specification");
- 5. Aim High's failure to clearly display a link to renewal fees, post-expiration renewal fees (if different) and redemption/restore fees on Aim High's website and provide a link to the renewal fees, post-expiration renewal fees (if different) and redemption/restore fees in Aim High's registration agreement, as required by Section 4.1 of the Expired Registration Recovery Policy ("ERRP");
- 6. Aim High's failure to publish an email address to receive abuse reports on the home page of Aim High's website, as required by Section 3.18.1 of the RAA;
- 7. Aim High's failure to publish a description of Aim High's procedures for the receipt, handling and tracking of abuse reports on Aim High's website, as required by Section 3.18.3 of the RAA; and
- 8. Aim High's failure to prohibit sublicense use of the ICANN logo to any other party, as required by the Logo License Specification of the RAA.

Please see the chronology below for additional details.

Aim High is further advised that the logo license granted in the Logo License Specification to the RAA is revoked as of 3 May 2017. Please remove all ICANN trademarks, name and logo from Aim High's website and business materials that have been licensed to Aim High under the terms of that Specification by 3 May 2017.

Domain Name Transition Process

To protect domain name registrants, ICANN will commence the domain name transition process and will solicit bids for a qualified ICANN-accredited registrar to manage the domain names currently managed by Aim High.



ICANN will follow the <u>De-Accredited Registrar Transition Procedure</u> ("Procedure"). Consistent with the Procedure, please designate a bulk transfer recipient by 10 April 2017 and inform ICANN's Registrar Liaison Team at <u>RegTransition@icann.org</u>.

ICANN reserves all its rights under the RAA. Please note the rights and obligations required to have effect after the expiration of the RAA, including but not limited to Sections 3.4 Retention of Registered Name Holder and Registration Data, 3.9 Accreditation Fees, 5.8 Resolution of Disputes Under this Agreement, and 5.9 Limitations on Monetary Remedies for Violations of this Agreement.

Aim High has currently due accreditation fees. These fees are required to be paid to ICANN by Section 3.9 of the RAA. Please immediately submit payment to ICANN accounting.
