RE: NOTICE OF BREACH OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Wafa Dahmani,

Please be advised that as of 6 December 2016, ATI is in breach of its Registrar Accreditation Agreement ("RAA") with the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers ("ICANN") dated 3 June 2015 ("RAA"). This breach results from:

1. ATI's failure to timely pay past due accreditation fees, as required by Section 3.9 of the RAA.

Additional Concerns

ICANN is unable to contact ATI by telephone or facsimile using the contact information provided to ICANN in RADAR.

ICANN requests that ATI cure these breaches by 27 December 2016, 21 days from the date of this letter, by taking the following actions:

1. Pay all past due accreditation fees;



- 2. Review and confirm ATI has provided ICANN with valid telephone and facsimile numbers for its contacts in RADAR, and if not update those numbers; and
- 3. Provide ICANN with corrective and preventative action(s), including implementation date(s), to ensure that ATI will timely make payment and respond to ICANN compliance matters.

If ATI fails to timely cure the breaches and provide the information requested by 27 December 2016, ICANN may commence the RAA termination process.
